What's Happening?

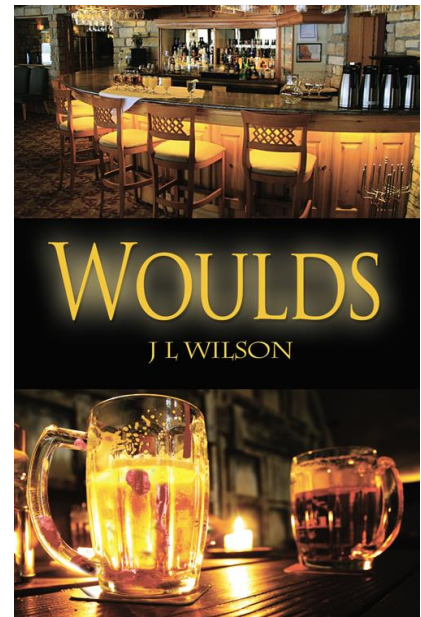

And I'm sorry to say that one of my publishers is folding. Yep, the folks at Resplendence Press have decided to close their doors. I have four books with them, so the rights will be returned to me and I will need to package those books up and sell them on my own.

Brilliant Disguise, *Lie to Me*, *Nowhere to Run*, and *Shadow of Doubt* will be edited a bit and given new covers. I also plan to edit *If Not For You* (which was returned to me earlier this year) and I will tie it in to the four books coming back. Then I plan to release them all as a boxed set on Amazon.

Isn't it lucky that I am now retired so I can spend some time working on things like this? I have a lot of information I've gleaned from conferences about how to handle a self-publishing career, and it looks like I will need to put it all to use. I want to set up my own "company" (an LLC), learn to format books, work with a cover artist on new covers, and figure out the copyright and other legal aspects.

What's Next?

It's Casino Time! My friends and I are heading to the wilds of Wisconsin to gamble and brainstorm books. I want to work out the details for my Little Mermaid book, and maybe gather some inspiration for the current book I'm writing.

It's another Celestial Service book, and I found a way to tie it into my Endless American Dream series. By the time I'm done, all of my History Patrol books, the Celestial Service books, my New Human books, and my Dream series books will all be tied together.

I re-did my wiki to keep track of all the series in one place and did a bit of tweaking on the History Patrol books to tie them in with the others. When the time comes (in a year or so), I hope to release all the Celestial Service books (three, by then), the History Patrol books (three of them), the New Human series (I'll have rights returned to me so I can tweak them), and my Dream Series books. Twenty books releasing in one year.

Yep. Glad I retired. I'm going to be busy!
